He probably **wants to stay** at home and he certainly **doesn't want to go** to school.

The title of the movie is Ferris Bueller's **day off**. Maybe it is about Ferris who **skips school** and **takes a day off**.

Grammaire : éléments de syntaxe à retenir

Pour parler de l'apparence (avoir l'air...): **(to) look + adjectif**

You look happy ! You don't look well.

Attention : ne pas confondre avec **(to) look at + GN = regarder**

Look at this photo !

Pour parler de ce que l'on veut faire : **(to) WANT + TO + BV**

I want to stay at home. I don't want to go to school.
