

## BACK TO SCHOOL – LESSON 2 : WHAT IS HAPPENING ? ACTIVITY 2 : WATCH AND UNDERSTAND - CORRECTION

### The situation:

**Who** are the people you see ?

The people in the video are Ferris, his parents and his sister

**Where** and **when** does the scene take place ?

The scene takes place at home in the morning.

**What** is happening (what is wrong with Ferris)?

Ferris is in bed, he looks sick and his parents are looking at him.

**How** do the people react ?

The parents look worried but his sister is angry.

**Is** Ferris really sick?

No, Ferris isn't really sick. He is pretending, he is lying.

**What** does he want ?

He doesn't want to go to school. He wants to skip school and to stay at home.

### What they say :

- 1) He doesn't have a fever but his stomach aches and he **is seeing** spots. His hands are cold.
- 2) What's the matter ? What's wrong ?
- 3) I have a test today. I have to take it. I want to go to college and have a fruitful life.
- 4) **You're letting** him stay home ? I can't believe this. This is so unfair.
- 5) It's nice to know that I have such lovely caring parents. You are so special.

## Résumé à mémoriser

Ferris is a **student**. He likes to **skip school** and he is **very good at** it.

In this **scene**, he **is pretending** that he **is feeling very sick** but that he **really wants to get up** and go to school because he has an **important test**.

His parents **believe** him and they are **worried** so they **want him to** stay in bed.

His sister **knows** that he **is lying** and that he **is faking everything** so she is **really upset** because the parents **are letting** him **stay at home**. She thinks it is **very unfair**.

## Grammaire : éléments de syntaxe à retenir

**Pour décrire une scène et ce qui se passe à ce moment là précisément:**

**Le présent BE+V-ING**

**Ferris is lying to his parents. He isn't telling the truth.**

**Pour dire ce que l'on veut que quelqu'un d'autre fasse :**

**(to) want + GN Complément + TO + BV**

**Ferris wants his parents to believe him.**

**The sister doesn't want the parents to believe him.**
